EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY 0800 243 622

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Wear protective clothing (overalls buttoned at wrist and neck), respirator, chemical resistant gloves, boots and goggles. Evacuate unnecessary personnel from the area. Sweep up product carefully to avoid creating dust and place in appropriate labelled container for disposal at an approved site. If spray solution is spilt, bund spill or absorb with inert absorbent material such as sand or clay granules. Sweep absorbent material into an appropriate labelled container and dispose at an approved facility. Cover the area with water and absorb. Prevent runoff entering waterways or contaminating soil.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. If involved in a fire use self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). Evacuate area and fight fire upwind from a safe distance to avoid hazardous vapours and decomposition products. Prevent run-off contaminating drains, sewers, or watercourses (bund if necessary); inform appropriate authorities immediately if product or run-off enters waterways.

FIRST AID

24 HOUR ADVICE IN A FIRST AID EMERGENCY 0800 POISON (0800 764 766)

If Swallowed:	Immediately call the National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON [0800 764 766]. Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately get medical advice.
If on Skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Do NOT scrub skin. If skin irritation or rash occurs, get medical attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical attention if you feel unwell.

Storage: Keep out of reach of children. Store in original container, tightly closed, in a dry, well ventilated place away from foodstuffs and animal feedstuffs. Store in accordance with The New Zealand Standard for the Management of Agrichemicals NZS8409.
